## What is a Reality House Party?

San Clemente teens will act out a typical weekend party within a “party house” recreated on the SCHS campus. Parents will tour through each “room” of the house guided by the organization Straight Up. Parents will learn what really goes on at house parties, the latest trends in teen partying and social media dangers. Past participants have been surprised by what they’ve learned.
